Dear Mr. LeClerc:

The United States Department of Energy (DOE) is pleased to submit the Soil Treatability Master Work Plan to support the Treatability Studies as required in Section 2.6 of the Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) that was signed by DOE and DTSC. As noted in Section 2.6, the AOC requires three deliverable types: work plan, sampling and analysis plan, and a treatability evaluation report. This document serves as the required work plan deliverable. DOE shall conduct treatability testing to develop data for assessing treatment on-site that could achieve the cleanup goals. Treatability testing is required to demonstrate the implementability and effectiveness of such technologies, unless DOE can show DTSC that similar data, documentation or information exists. This plan was developed for DOE by CDM Federal Programs Corporation. DTSC has the regulatory authority for approving this workplan and subsequent documents thereafter. DOE has been working with your staff and all initial comments and concerns have been addressed.
