On September 6, 2013, Ms. Melissa Garcia, Courtroom Clerk to the Honorable Allen Sumner, the presiding judge in this matter, notified the parties that the Court will not hear Petitioner's motion for a preliminary injunction until October 25, 2013. In that email message, the Court asked if the parties would be willing to extend their agreements to preserve the status quo until November 1, 2013.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) hereby extends until November 1, 2013, the moratorium it set out in my August 8, 2013, letter to you.
