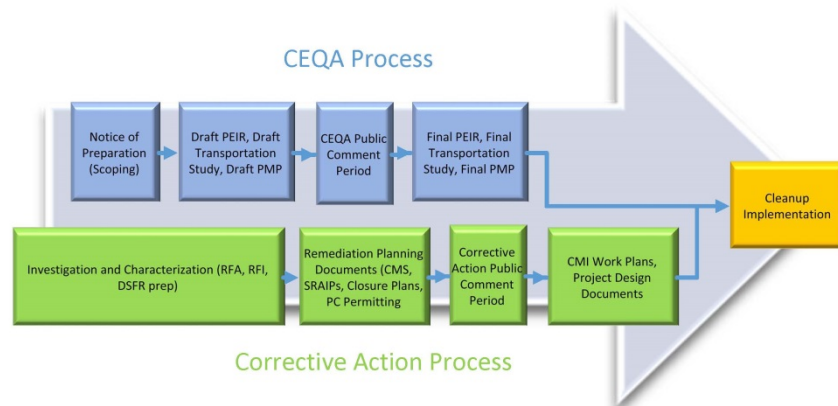




Overview of CEQA Process

- Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) DTSC is required to evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed soil and groundwater remediation activities at Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL).
- The evaluation process is conducted through preparation of a Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (PEIR).
- In parallel with CEQA all three Responsible Parties (RP) will:
 - Complete Investigation and Characterization.
 - Prepare Remediation Planning Documents, describing proposed cleanup measures for each Administrative Area.
- DTSC will review, comment and then release each Remediation Planning Document for public comment.



Progress Made

Administrative Draft of PEIR

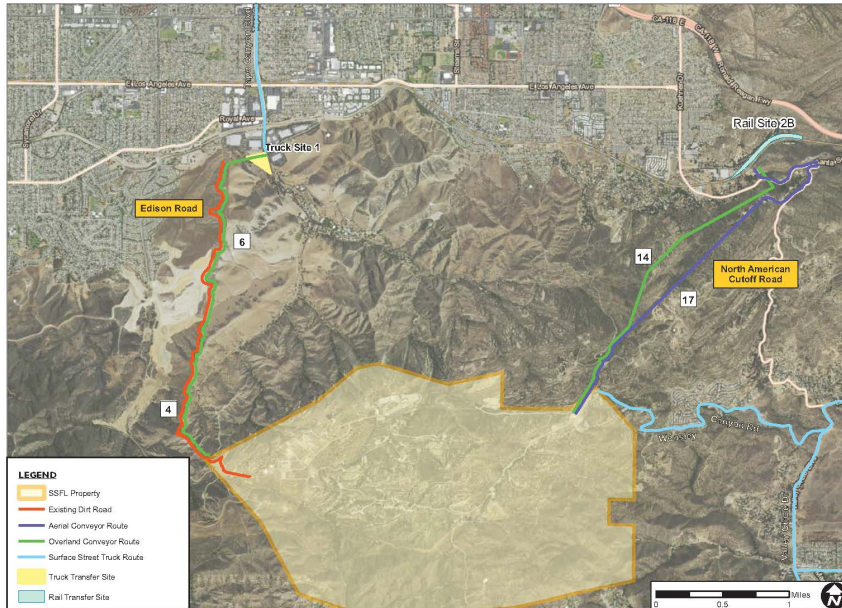
- Completed Project Description.
- Completed several impact analysis sections.
- Biological impact evaluation ongoing.
- Cultural impact evaluation ongoing.
- Evaluation of project alternatives, ongoing.

Transportation Study

- Completed screening of over 25 separate potential transportation options.
- Completed detailed evaluation of three potential conveyor routes (one aerial conveyor, two surface conveyor routes, see next page figure).
- Completed detailed evaluation of two potential trucking routes, see next page figure.
- Completed detailed evaluation of three transfer facility locations.
- Anticipate releasing Transportation Feasibility Analysis as Appendix to PEIR.

- Finalize Remediation Planning Documents (anticipated spring 2017).
