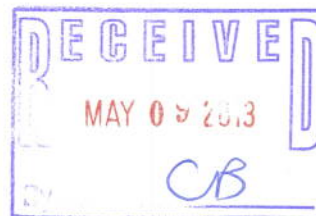

Subject: Submittal of Former Weather Station Removal Summary Report
Boeing Santa Susana Field Laboratory, Ventura County, California

At the request of the Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC), the Boeing Company (Boeing) provides this post-demolition summary report with information that describes the demolition debris results and subsurface observations (if any) after demolition completion of the former Weather Station, located within Administrative Area IV.

Providing this post-demolition summary report is consistent with the request made by the DTSC within the February 11, 2010 memorandum, "DTSC Comments on Draft Standard Operating Procedures for Building Demolition Debris Characterization and Management".

Demolition/removals were performed using the Boeing protocols established in the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP): Building Demolition and Debris Characterization and Management for the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (Boeing, 2010) and Standard Operating Procedures, Boeing Demolition Debris Characterization and Management, Amendment 1 that applies to non-radiological Boeing-owned buildings in Area IV dated November 01, 2012.
