On behalf of the Department of Energy (DOE), The Boeing Company (Boeing) is pleased to submit the RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) Work Plan Addendum, Second Amendment for sampling and analysis activities performed at the Radioactive Materials Handling Facility (RMHF) located in Area IV at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL).

As described in the March 2008 RMHF Work Plan Addendum Amendment (WPAA), RFI sampling in accessible portions of the site was proposed to be completed prior to the DOE release of the RMHF for unrestricted use to allow for timely RFI reporting and progress toward site closure. DTSC has reviewed the WPAA and, during site visits and meetings with Boeing in March and April 2008, requested additional information. DTSC also asked for modifications to the proposed investigation activities. The second amendment is being submitted in response to DTSC's request for an amendment to the WPAA that documents the information provided to DTSC during the implementation of the WPAA and that presents modifications in the field program.

DOE and Boeing respectfully ask that DTSC staff review this amendment to the March 2008 RMHF WPAA at their earliest convenience and provide a memorandum approving the revised scope of work.
