The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received and is reviewing the above referenced Closure Plan. The Closure Plan addresses the hazardous waste management requirements for closure of Buildings 4021, 4022, and 4621 as well as the Outdoor Mixed Waste Storage Yard. The Department of Energy's (DOE) obligations with respect to the cleanup of the soils at SSFL, including soils around this facility, shall require compliance with and fulfillment of the obligations required by the 2010 Administrative Order on Consent for Remedial Action, HSA-CO 10/11-037.

Once DTSC completes our Closure Plan Review, DTSC will either request additional modifications or release the document for public review and comment in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Section 66265.112(c)(1)(A) & (d)(5).

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Regardless of when both DTSC's review and the public comment period are completed, DTSC will not approve the Closure Plan for implementation until both DTSC's Environmental Impact Report (EIR), as well as DOE's Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) are certified, currently anticipated in late 2016. DTSC appreciates DOE's proactive role in preparing this closure plan so that multiple SSFL decision documents can be finalized in an expedited manner once the EIR and EIS for SSFL are completed.
