What is a Closure Plan?

- Describes steps to be taken to clean up hazardous waste and hazardous waste constituent residues so they are no longer a threat to public health and the environment.
- DTSC regulates hazardous waste closure (decontamination) through RCRA hazardous waste regulations.
- Proposed Closure (cleanup) activities are for ***buildings and building debris***.
- Underlying contamination will be addressed under the 2010 Administrative Order on Consent (for soil) and the 2007 Consent Order (for groundwater).
- Proposed closure actions were evaluated under the California Environmental Quality Act in DTSC's 2017 Draft Program Environmental Impact Report.
- **Removal of buildings through closure is the first step to take towards soils cleanup.**
