### Swift discusses 'weird rumors' and Joe Alwyn

Taylor Swift is addressing how she copes with "weird rumors" about her six-year relationship.



The Grammy winner discussed her upcoming album, "Midnights," in an Instagram video posted early Friday, and the influence her long-term relationship with Joe Alwyn had on the first track, "Lavender Haze."

"I happened upon the phrase 'lavender haze' when I was watching 'Mad Men.' And I looked it up, because I thought it sounded cool," Swift, 32, said in the clip. "And it turns out that it's a common phrase used in the '50s where they would just describe being in love, like if you were in the lavender haze that that meant you were in that all-encompassing love glow."

"And if the world finds out that you're in love with somebody, they're gonna weigh in on it. Like my relationship for 6 years, we've had to dodge weird rumors, tabloid stuff. And we just ignore it. And so this song is sort of about the act of ignoring that stuff to protect the real stuff."

The rumor remark appeared to point, in part, toward reports in February that she and the British "Conversations With Friends" star, 31, were engaged. Days before, Alwyn said he is "obviously happy in a monogamous relationship."

Though little is known about the couple's life together, they collaborated on Swift's 2020 album, "Folklore," and took home

After a news report circulated Friday morning — before it was quickly unpublished — that the Rock & Roll Hall of Famer died, a rep clarified that Mitchell is very much alive.

"I can confirm that Joni is alive and well and the People report was not accurate," a publicist for Rhino Entertainment said Friday afternoon. The prewritten obituary that was published included editorial notes for details that needed to be filled in.

"Joni Mitchell Dies at TK AGE," read the headline that was seen on the website as well as in a tweet; "TK" is a term journalists use to mean "to come."

### Jared Leto plans to play Karl Lagerfeld in biopic

Jared Leto will star in and pro-

duce a biopic of Karl Lagerfeld, Women's Wear Daily reports.

The Oscar winner says he thinks the late fashion designer and former artistic director of Chanel would approve.

# DTSC PUBLIC NOTICE

DTSC's Mission is to protect California's people, communities, and environment from toxic substances, to enhance economic vitality by restoring contaminated land, and to compel manufacturers to make safer consumer products.

## DEPARTMENT OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL BOEING LAND USE COVENANT AND AGREEMENT

A Land Use Covenant and Agreement (Covenant) has been made by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and The Boeing company regarding the property owned by Boeing, at 5800 Woolsey Canyon Road in Ventura County. The Covenant is necessary to protect present or future human health and safety and the environment from hazardous materials in the groundwater under the Property. The Property is a large portion of the former Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL).

The groundwater at the Property contains hazardous materials, including volatile organic compounds, semi-volatile organic compounds, polychlorinated biphenyls, dioxins and furans, pesticides, herbicides, energetics and radionuclides at levels above drinking water standards. DTSC concluded the necessity to restrict use of the groundwater at the Property and enter into the Covenant pursuant to Civil Code section 1471 and Section 4.d.4 of the Settlement Agreement. Violation of the Covenant shall be grounds for DTSC to pursue administrative, civil, or criminal actions, as provided by law. Extraction or removal of groundwater at or from the Property for human consumption or domestic uses shall not be permitted or conducted without prior written approval by DTSC. The Covenant can be found on the DTSC SSFL website. The general provisions of the Covenant:

- **Runs with the Land.** The Covenant sets Environmental Restrictions to the Property no matter how it is improved, held, used, occupied, leased, or sold.
- **Binding upon Owners/Occupants.** The Covenant binds all Owners and Occupants of the Property, their heirs, successors, and guardians.
- **Incorporation into Deeds and Leases.** The Covenant is attached to each and every deed and Lease for any portion of the Property.
- **Conveyance of Property.** Each Owner should notify DTSC within 30 calendar days regarding the intended transfer of the Property.
- **Costs of Administering Covenant to Be Paid by Owner.** The Owner agrees to pay DTSC's costs to administer, implement, and enforce the Covenant based on California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 67391.1(h).


